

North Lanarkshire Council
Johnston Avenue, Kilsyth
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020

On 20 January 2020 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on sewer replacement works) on Johnston Avenue, Kilsyth from Jarvie Crescent to B802 Howe Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles should proceed on Johnston Avenue, Edmonstone Drive, Manse Road and B802 Howe Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

The Order, which continues the restrictions currently in place by virtue of a similar Order made by the Council on Monday, 19 August 2019, will come into operation at 2359 hours on Friday, 31 January 2020 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 28 February 2020.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Johnston Avenue, Kilsyth) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020” which continues the restrictions currently in operation by virtue of a similar Order made by the Council on Monday, the nineteenth day of August, Two thousand and nineteen, and shall be effective during the period from 2359 hours on Friday, the thirty-first day of January, Two thousand and twenty until 2359 hours on Friday, the twenty-eighth day of February, Two thousand and twenty.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on sewer replacement works) on Johnston Avenue, Kilsyth from Jarvie Crescent to B802 Howe Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles should proceed on Johnston Avenue, Edmonstone Drive, Manse Road and B802 Howe Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
