B7011 Brownlee Road, Garrion
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2019

On 4 November 2019 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway widening and improvement works) on B7011 Brownlee Road, Garrion from the extended south east kerb line of the A71 Horsley Brae, eastwards for a distance of 150 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on B7011 Brownlee Road/Station Road/Wildman Road, north westwards on the A73, westwards on A721 Wishaw Road, south westwards on A71 Overtown Road/Main Street/Horsley Brae to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

The Order, which will only be operational when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 18 November 2019 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 31 January 2020.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (B7011 Brownlee Road, Garrion) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2019” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the eighteenth day of November, Two thousand and nineteen until 2359 hours on Friday, the thirty-first day of January, Two thousand and twenty.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway widening and improvement works) on B7011 Brownlee Road, Garrion from the extended south east kerb line of the A71 Horsley Brae, eastwards for a distance of 150 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on B7011 Brownlee Road/Station Road/Wildman Road, north westwards on the A73, westwards on A721 Wishaw Road, south westwards on A71 Overtown Road/Main Street/Horsley Brae to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
