**Main Street, Bellshill – Christmas Lights Switch On**

**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2019**

On 11 November 2019 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 16a of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the Annual Christmas Lights Switch On Event) on Main Street, Bellshill from the entrance to Orchard Court, eastwards to its termination at 162 Main Street or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: There are no alternative routes.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 29 November 2019.

**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2019**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16a of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Main Street, Bellshill – Christmas Lights Switch On) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2019” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours until 2359 hours on Friday, the twenty-ninth day of November, Two thousand and nineteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the Annual Christmas Lights Switch On Event) on Main Street, Bellshill from the entrance to Orchard Court, eastwards to its termination at 162 Main Street or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: There are no alternative routes.*
