

North Lanarkshire Council
Abernethyn Road, Newmains
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020

On 13 January 2020 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on building works associated with an adjacent development) on Abernethyn Road, Newmains from the extended north kerbline of Muirhouse Avenue, eastwards for a distance of 140 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed eastwards on Muirhouse Avenue, north eastwards on Bonkle Road, north westwards on Alcath Road, westwards on Firtree Road and southwards on Abernethyn Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 27 January 2020 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 1 March 2020.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Abernethyn Road, Newmains) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty-seventh day of January, Two thousand and twenty until 2359 hours on Sunday, the first day of March, Two thousand and twenty.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on building works associated with an adjacent development) on Abernethyn Road, Newmains from the extended north kerbline of Muirhouse Avenue, eastwards for a distance of 140 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed eastwards on Muirhouse Avenue, north eastwards on Bonkle Road, north westwards on Alcath Road, westwards on Firtree Road and southwards on Abernethyn Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
