

North Lanarkshire Council
Crossgates, Bellshill
(Temporary Closure) Order 2020

On 17 February 2020 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Gas Mains Renewal) on Crossgates, Bellshill from its junction with B7070 Hamilton Road, south eastwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes for vehicles of a height less than 14' 3³/₄.3m on the west side of the closure should proceed on B7070 Hamilton Road, A721 North Road, A775 Campbell Street, A775 Main Street, B7029 Calder Road, Calder Road, A721 Motherwell Road then Crossgates.

Vehicles of a height less than 14' 3³/₄.3m on the east side of the closure should proceed on Crossgates, A721 Motherwell Road and Main Street and then B7070 Hamilton Road.

Vehicles of a height equal to, or greater than 14' 3³/₄.3m on the west side of the closure should proceed on B7070 Hamilton Road, A725 Bellshill Road, A721 Gartcosh Walk, A775 Campbell Street, A775 Main Street, B7029 Calder Road, Calder Road, A721 Motherwell Road and then Crossgates.

Vehicles of a height equal to, or greater than 14' 3³/₄.3m on the east side of the closure should proceed on Crossgates, A721 Motherwell Road, Calder Road, B7029 Calder Road, A775 Main Street, A775 Campbell Street, A721 Gartcosh Walk, A725 Bellshill Road and B7070 Hamilton Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 2 March 2020 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Monday, 16 March 2020.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Crossgates, Bellshill) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020” and shall be effective during the period from 00001 hours on Monday, the second day of March, Two thousand and twenty until 2359 hours on Monday, the sixteenth day of March, Two thousand and twenty.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Gas Mains Renewal) on Crossgates, Bellshill from its junction with B7070 Hamilton Road, south eastwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes for vehicles of a height less than 14' 3"/4.3m on the west side of the closure should proceed on B7070 Hamilton Road, A721 North Road, A775 Campbell Street, A775 Main Street, B7029 Calder Road, Calder Road, A721 Motherwell Road then Crossgates.

Vehicles of a height less than 14' 3"/4.3m on the east side of the closure should proceed on Crossgates, A721 Motherwell Road and Main Street and then B7070 Hamilton Road.

Vehicles of a height equal to, or greater than 14' 3"/4.3m on the west side of the closure should proceed on B7070 Hamilton Road, A725 Bellshill Road, A721 Gartcosh Walk, A775 Campbell Street, A775 Main Street, B7029 Calder Road, Calder Road, A721 Motherwell Road and then Crossgates.

Vehicles of a height equal to, or greater than 14' 3"/4.3m on the east side of the closure should proceed on Crossgates, A721 Motherwell Road, Calder Road, B7029 Calder Road, A775 Main Street, A775 Campbell Street, A721 Gartcosh Walk, A725 Bellshill Road and B7070 Hamilton Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
