

North Lanarkshire Council
Blair Road, Coatbridge
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020

On 4 March 2020 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on works connected to the upgrading of the train station) on Blair Road, Coatbridge from Corsewall Street to Espieside Crescent or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles 15'3" (4.7m) or less in height should proceed on Blair Road, A89 (Bank Street, Glasgow Road, Coatbridge Road), A725 Gartcosh Road and Townhead Road.

Vehicles greater than 15'3" (4.7m) in height should proceed on Blair Road, A89 (Bank Street, Glasgow Road, Coatbridge Road), A8 Edinburgh Road, Easterhouse Road, Westerhouse Road, Lochend Road, Gartcosh Road and Townhead Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 2000 hours on Saturdays until 0800 hours on Sundays, from 2000 hours on Saturday, the fourteenth day of March 2020 and will remain in operation until 0800 hours on Sunday, the twenty-ninth day of March 2020.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Blair Road, Coatbridge) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020” and shall be effective during the period from 2000 hours on Saturdays until 0800 hours on Sundays from 2000 hours on Saturday, the fourteenth day of March, Two thousand and twenty until 0800 hours on Sunday, the twenty-ninth day of March, Two thousand and twenty.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on works connected to the upgrading of the train station) on Blair Road, Coatbridge from Corsewall Street to Espieside Crescent or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles 15’3” (4.7m) or less in height should proceed on Blair Road, A89 (Bank Street, Glasgow Road, Coatbridge Road), A725 Gartcosh Road and Townhead Road.

Vehicles greater than 15’3” (4.7m) in height should proceed on Blair Road, A89 (Bank Street, Glasgow Road, Coatbridge Road), A8 Edinburgh Road, Easterhouse Road, Westerhouse Road, Lochend Road, Gartcosh Road and Townhead Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
