VARIOUS STREETS, HOLYTOWN

(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (VARIATION) ORDER 2020

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Various Streets, Holytown) (30 MPH Speed Limit) (Variation) Order 2020" and shall come into operation on Monday, the thirteenth day of April, Two thousand and twenty.
2. Upon the coming into effect of this Order, the Orders specified in the Schedule to this Order shall have effect, subject to amendments specified in that Schedule.

ORDERS TO BE AMENDED

The North Lanarkshire Council (Various Streets, Holytown) (30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2011

Schedule I in so far as it relates to A723 Carfin to Holytown Link Road, Holytown

Amend From

The length of the A723 Carfin to Holytown Link Road, Holytown from the centreline of the A775 Edinburgh Road, southwards for a distance of 49 metres or thereby.

Amend To

The length of the A723 Carfin to Holytown Link Road, Holytown from the centreline of the A775 Edinburgh Road, southwards for a distance of 348 metres or thereby.
