**Carnbroe Road, Carnbroe**

**Temporary (Road Closure) Order 2020**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Carnbroe Road, Carnbroe) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020" and shall be effective only when displayed by signs, during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty-ninth day of June, Two thousand and twenty until 2359 hours on Sunday, the ninth day of August, Two thousand and twenty.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the construction of a new road layout) on Carnbroe Road, Carnbroe from A8 Glasgow and Edinburgh Road to the roundabout at Drummore Avenue or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on A8 Glasgow and Edinburgh Road at the south side of the closure wishing to travel to Carnbroe Road at the north side of the closure should travel eastwards on A8 Glasgow and Edinburgh Road, northwards on B802 (Woodhall Mill Road, Main Street and Calderbank Road) westwards on B802 Calderbank Road, westwards on Sykeside Road, westwards on Paddock Street and southwards on Carnbroe Road to the north side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on Carnbroe Road at the north side of the closure wishing to travel to A8 Glasgow and Edinburgh Road at the south side of the closure should travel northwards on Carnbroe Road, eastwards on Paddock Street, eastwards on Sykeside Road, eastwards on B802 Calderbank Road, southwards on B802 (Calderbank Road, Main Street and Woodhall Mill Road) then follow normal directional signage.*
