Burnhead Road, Airdrie

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Burnhead Road, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty-ninth day of June, Two thousand and twenty until 2359 hours on Tuesday, the twenty-eighth day of December, Two thousand and twenty-one.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of emergency service vehicles) on Burnhead Road, Airdrie from a point 8 metres east of the junction with Picton Grove, eastwards to a point 108 metres northwest of the junction with Connor Street/Church Crescent, a distance of 847 metres or thereby by reason of protecting public health and promoting social distancing near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south east side of the closure should proceed southwards on Burnhead Road and Connor Street, westwards on B8058, north westwards on A73 Motherwell Street, eastwards on Airdriehill Street and Burnhead Road to the northwest side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian and bicycle access will be maintained at all times.
