Victoria Place, Airdrie

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Victoria Place, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the tenth day of August, Two thousand and twenty until 2359 hours on Sunday, the fourth day of October, Two thousand and twenty.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas main works) on Victoria Place, Airdrie (Westbound Carriageway) from the extended west kerb line of B802 Cairnhill Road, westwards to the extended kerb wline of Woodburn Avenue by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on B802 Cairnhill Road at the east side of the closure wishing to travel to Victoria Place at the west side of the closure should travel generally southwards on B802 Cairnhill Road, eastwards on Hogg Street, northwards on Gartlea Road, westwards on A89 (Weavers Road, Alexander Street, Deedes Street, Main Street), south eastwards on Rochsolloch Road and eastwards on Victoria Place to the west side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
