

**North Lanarkshire Council**

**McNeil Drive, Holytown**

**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 62 of the Road (Scotland) Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (McNeil Drive, Holytown) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020" and shall be effective, only when appropriate signage is in place, during the period from 0001 hours on Wednesday, the sixteenth day of December until 0600 hours on Thursday, the seventeenth day of December, Two thousand and twenty.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on filming operations) on McNeil Drive, Holytown from the extended east kerbline of the western roundabout junction with Coddington Crescent to the extended west kerbline of the eastern roundabout junction with Coddington Crescent, a distance of 705m or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes:* Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed south eastwards and eastwards on Coddington Crescent to the east side of the closure.

*Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*
