(Temporary 30 MPH Speed Restriction) Order 2021

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (A73, Newmains) (Temporary 30 MPH Speed Restriction) Order 2021" which will only be operational when displayed with signs, and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty-ninth day of March, Two thousand and twenty-one until 2359 hours on Sunday, the ninth day of May, Two thousand and twenty-one.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 MPH on A73, Newmains (North westbound carriageway) from the roundabout junction of A73 and McCarrison Road, north westwards for a distance of 400 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
