Bonkle Road, Newmains

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2021

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Bonkle Road, Newmains) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2021" and shall be effective, only weekends only, during the period from 0001 hours on Saturday, the thirty-first day of July, Two thousand and twenty-one until 2359 hours on Sunday, the eighth day of August, Two thousand and twenty-one.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Water Utility Maintenance works) on Bonkle Road, Newmains from the roundabout junction with A71 Morningside Road, north eastwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed via A71 Morningside Road, A71 Allanton Road and Bonkle Road.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises and/or roads will be maintained, where practicable, by arrangement with the contractor, during the closure.
