## Un-named Footpath at Wardpark Road, Cumbernauld

## (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2021

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Un-named Footpath at Wardpark Road, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2021" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Tuesday, the twenty seventh day of July, Two thousand and twenty-one until 2359 hours on Monday, the nineth day of August, Two thousand and twenty-one.
- No person shall proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on Scottish Power cable excavation works) on Un-named Footpath, Cumbernauld from B816 Castlecary Road to Wardpark Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on B816 Castlecary Road on the north side of the closure wishing to access Wardpark Road on the south of the closure should proceed north eastwards on B816 Castlecary Road, south eastwards on the un-named footpath to Dunnswood Road, south eastwards on the north side of Dunnswood Road, south eastwards to the southwest side of Forest Road and south westwards on Wardpark Road.

Pedestrians on the south side of the closure wishing to access B816 Castlecary Road should proceed vice versa.
