

**North Lanarkshire Council**

**Craigneuk Avenue, Airdrie**

**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2021**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Craigneuk Avenue, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2021" and shall be effective, only when displayed by signs, during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty sixth day of July, Two thousand and twenty-one until 2359 hours on Friday, the twenty ninth day of October, Two thousand and twenty-one.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on sewer works) on Craigneuk Road, Airdrie from the extended west gable wall line of 61 Craigneuk Avenue north eastwards to the extended north gable wall line of 41 Craigneuk Avenue by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on Craigneuk Avenue at the west side of the closure wishing to travel to Sycamore Drive at the south side of the closure should travel generally south-westwards on Craigneuk Avenue, eastwards on Howletnest Road, north-westwards on Hawthorn Drive, westwards on Sycamore Drive, to the south side of the closure and vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Craigneuk Avenue at the west side of the closure wishing to travel to Craigneuk Avenue at the east side of the closure should travel generally south-westwards on Craigneuk Avenue, eastwards on Howletnest Road, north-westwards on Hawthorn Drive, south-westwards on Craigneuk Avenue, to the east side of the closure and vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Craigneuk Avenue at the west side of the closure wishing to travel to Holly Street at the north side of the closure should travel generally south-westwards on Craigneuk Avenue, eastwards on Howletnest Road, north-westwards on Hawthorn Drive, south-westwards on Oakbank Street, north-westwards on Poplar Street, south-westwards on Willow Drive, south-eastwards on Holly Street, to the north side of the closure and vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Sycamore Drive at the south side of the closure wishing to travel to Craigneuk Avenue at the east side of the closure should travel generally eastwards on Sycamore Drive, north-westwards on Hawthorn Drive, south-westwards on Craigneuk Avenue, to the east side of the closure and vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Sycamore Drive at the south side of the closure wishing to travel to Holly Street at the north side of the closure should travel generally eastwards on Sycamore Drive, north-westwards on Hawthorn Drive, south-westwards on Oakbank Street, north-westwards on Poplar Street, south-westwards on Willow Drive, south-eastwards on Holly Street, to the north side of the closure and vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Craigneuk Avenue at the east side of the closure wishing to travel to Holly Street at the north side of the closure should travel generally north-eastwards on Craigneuk Avenue, north-westwards on Hawthorn Drive, south-westwards on Oakbank Street, north-westwards*

*on Poplar Street, south-westwards on Willow Drive, south-eastwards on Holly Street, to the north side of the closure and vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained where practicable.

Vehicular access will be maintained for residents, where practicable, during the closure.
