(Temporary Road Closure) Order No 2 2021

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Hawthorn Drive, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order No 2 2021" which continues the restrictions currently in operation by virtue of a similar Order made by the Council on Tuesday, the first day of June, Two thousand and twenty-one, and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Wednesday, the ninth day of June, Two thousand and twenty-one until 2359 hours on Friday, the sixth day of August, Two thousand and twenty-one.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Water – sewer works) on Hawthorn Drive, Airdrie from the north kerb line of Oakbank Street, south-eastwards to the extended north gable wall line of 28 Hawthorn Drive by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on Oakbank Street at the north-west side of the closure wishing to travel to Oakbank Street at the east side of the closure should travel generally south-westwards on Oakbank Street, north-westwards on Poplar Street, eastwards on Willow Drive, south-westwards on Oakbank Street, to the east side of the closure and vice versa.

Vehicles on Oakbank Street at the north-west side of the closure wishing to travel to Craigneuk Avenue at the east side of the closure should travel generally south-westwards on Oakbank Street, north-westwards on Poplar Street, eastwards on Willow Drive, south-westwards on Craigneuk Avenue, to the east side of the closure and vice versa.

Vehicles on Oakbank Street at the north-west side of the closure wishing to travel to Hawthorn Drive at the south side of the closure should travel generally south-westwards on Oakbank Street, north-westwards on Poplar Street, eastwards on Willow Drive, south-eastwards on Bankhead Avenue, south-westwards on Howletnest Road, north-westwards on Hawthorn Drive to the south side of the closure and vice versa.

Vehicles on Oakbank Street at the north-west side of the closure wishing to travel to Craigneuk Avenue at the west side of the closure should travel generally south-westwards on Oakbank Street, north-westwards on Poplar Street, south-westwards on Willow Drive, south-eastwards on Holly Street, north-eastwards on Craigneuk Avenue, to the west side of the closure and vice versa.

Vehicles on Oakbank Street at the north-east side of the closure wishing to travel to Craigneuk Avenue at the east side of the closure should travel generally north-

eastwards on Oakbank Street, south-eastwards on Willow Drive, south-westwards on Craigneuk Avenue, to the east side of the closure and vice versa.

Vehicles on Oakbank Street at the north-east side of the closure wishing to travel to Hawthorn Drive at the south side of the closure should travel generally north-eastwards on Oakbank Street, south-eastwards on Willow Drive, south-eastwards on Bankhead Avenue, south-westwards on Howletnest Road, north-westwards on Hawthorn Drive to the south side of the closure and vice versa.

Vehicles on Oakbank Street at the north-east side of the closure wishing to travel to Craigneuk Avenue at the west side of the closure should travel generally north-eastwards on Oakbank Street, south-westwards on Willow Drive, south-eastwards on Holly Street, north-eastwards on Craigneuk Avenue, to the west side of the closure and vice versa.

Vehicles on Craigneuk Avenue at the east side of the closure wishing to travel to Hawthorn Drive at the south side of the closure should travel generally north-eastwards on Craigneuk Avenue, eastwards on Willow Drive, south-eastwards on Bankhead Avenue, south-westwards on Howletnest Road, north-westwards on Hawthorn Drive to the south-east side of the closure and vice versa.

Vehicles on Craigneuk Avenue at the east side of the closure wishing to travel to Craigneuk Avenue at the west side of the closure should travel generally north-eastwards on Craigneuk Avenue, westwards on Willow Drive, south-eastwards on Holly Street, north-eastwards on Craigneuk Avenue, to the west side of the closure and vice versa.

Vehicles on Hawthorn Drive at the south side of the closure wishing to travel to Craigneuk Avenue at the west side of the closure should travel generally south-eastwards on Hawthorn Drive, north-eastwards on Howletnest Road, north-westwards on Bankhead Avenue, westwards on Willow Drive, south-eastwards on Holly Street, north-eastwards on Craigneuk Avenue, to the west side of the closure and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained where practical during the closure.

Vehicular access will be maintained for residents, where practicable, during the closure.
