North Carbrain Road, Cumbernauld

(Temporary Road Closures) Order 2021

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (North Carbrain Road, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Road Closures) Order 2021" will only be operational when displayed by signs and shall be effective, during the period from 0600 hours on Monday, the sixteenth day of August, Two thousand and twenty-one until 1800 hours on Friday, the tenth day of September, Two thousand and twenty-one.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Carriageway Resurfacing Works) on North Carbrain Road, Cumbernauld as detailed undernoted, by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Phase 1

From its junction with Carbrain West Bridge to its junction with Glenacre Road.

Phase 2

From its junction with Hillcrest Road to its junction with Glenacre Road.

Phase 3

From its junction with Hillcrest Road to its junction with Beechwood Road.

Alternative routes (for Phases 1, 2 and 3): Vehicles on the west side of the closure will be diverted via North Carbrain Road, Seafar Roundabout, Slip Road 1, A8011 Central Way, McIntosh Way and North Carbrain Road.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure will be diverted via North Carbrain Road, McIntosh, A8011 Central Way, Slip Road 2 and North Carbrain Road.

Phase 4

From its junction with Beechwood Road to its junction with McIntosh Way.

From its junction with Craigieburn Road to its junction with McIntosh Way (Westbound Only).

Alternative routes (for Phase 4): Vehicles on the west side of the closure will be diverted via North Carbrain Road, Seafar Roundabout, Slip Road 1, A8011 Central Way, McIntosh Way and North Carbrain Road.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure will be diverted via North Carbrain Road, Yule Way, A8011 Central Way, Slip Road 2 and North Carbrain Road.

These works will be carried out as part of a rolling programme and only 1 phase will be operational at any one time.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
