### **Castleary Road**

A local resident complained about lorries creating a hazard by parking on the pavement near to the Shell Filling Station on Castleary Road. Tom contacted Community Police Officer Eddie Gilmartin, to establish if anything could be done about this matter. The police stated that extra attention would be given along this part of the road. Their view is that enough room should be left on the pavement for a wheelchair or pram to pass, and also there should be enough room to allow a fire appliance to pass on the roadway.
