Police Report

Ogilvie Homes

Ogilvie Homes recent appeal via the Court of Session, to build 9 nine new houses on land at Kings Drive, has been rejected by the Scottish Government. It insisted protection had to be given to the site as it was part of a Green Network/Green Belt area.

Scams

The latest scam warnings include Royal Mail, Scottish Water and Investments.

Dog Fouling

Several signs have now been put in place around the golf course to remind dog owners to place dog litter in the bins provided for this purpose.

Litter Bins

A number of large black bins are now in situ around Westerwood. In particular, the one located near the entrance to Queens Drive seemed to be used for depositing household rubbish and will require to be emptied within the projected 3-week cycle.

Dullatur Golf Club

Plans for the development of Dullatur Golf Club, which will bring additional pressure on transport and parking facilities at Croy Station, seem to be progressing rapidly despite the many objections raised by local residents.
