

North Lanarkshire Council
Townhead Avenue, Eurocentral, Holytown
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2021

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Townhead Avenue, Eurocentral, Holytown) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2021" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the nineteenth day of April, Two thousand and twenty-one until 2359 hours on Sunday, the eighth day of August, Two thousand and twenty-one.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on sewerage realignment works) on Townhead Avenue, Eurocentral, Holytown from the extended line of the western kerbline of Brittain Way north westwards for a distance of 560 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing access to the north side of the closure should travel northwards on Brittain Way, north-westwards on Coddington Crescent, westwards on McNeil Drive and southwards on Townhead Avenue to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
