Fife Drive, Motherwell

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2021

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Fife Drive, Motherwell) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2021" and shall be effective, only when appropriate signage is in place, during the period from 0001 hours on Thursday, the eighth day of July, Two thousand and twenty-one until 2359 hours on Thursday, the eighteenth day of August, Two thousand and twenty-one.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on sewer realignment works) on Fife Drive, Motherwell from a point 100m or thereby north of the extended kerbline of Tailsman Crescent northwards for a distance of 105m or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing access to the north side of the closure should travel southwards on Fife Drive, north-westwards on Lorne Drive, northwards on Kinloch Drive then south-eastwards on Fife Drive to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
