A89 Bank Street and Ross Street, Coatbridge

(Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2021

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (A89 Bank Street and Ross Street, Coatbridge) (Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2021" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the fifteenth day of February, Two thousand and twenty-one until 2359 hours on Friday, the twenty-sixth day of February, Two thousand and twenty-one.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on manhole repair works) on A89 Bank Street, Coatbridge (Eastbound) from its junction with Dundyvan Road to its junction with A89 South Circular Road, Coatbridge by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles should proceed on B753 Dundyvan Road, A725 Coatbank Street and A89 South Circular Road.

Temporary Prohibition of Right Turn Manoeuvre

From Ross Street, Coatbridge onto A89 Bank Street.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
