

**North Lanarkshire Council**  
**Legbrannock Road, Newarthill**  
**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2021**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Legbrannock Road, Newarthill) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2021" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Wednesday, the twelfth day of May, Two thousand and twenty-one until 2359 hours on Wednesday, the sixteenth day of June, Two thousand and twenty-one.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on installation of underground apparatus) on Legbrannock Road, Newarthill from its junction with Kirkoswald Road, north eastwards for a distance of 440 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Church Street, westwards on B7066 High Street and Loanhead Road, northwards on A723, north eastwards on A775 Edinburg Road and south eastwards on Legbrannock Road to the north west side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
