Townhead Avenue, Eurocentral, Holytown
(Temporary One Way) Order 2021

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Townhead Avenue, Eurocentral, Holytown) (Temporary One Way) Order 2021" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty-second day of November, Two thousand and twenty-one until 2359 hours on Friday, the tenth day of December, Two thousand and twenty-one.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Power Network Improvement Works) on Townhead Avenue, Eurocentral, Holytown from its junction with McNeil Drive to its junction with Brittain Way by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: vehicles on the southeast side of the closure wishing to travel to the northwest side of the closure should proceed via Brittain Way, Coddington Crescent and McNeil Drive.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
