Willow Drive, Airdrie

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2021

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Willow Drive, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2021" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twelfth day of April, Two thousand and twenty-one until 2359 hours on Friday, eighteenth day of June, Two thousand and twenty-one.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Water Sewer Works) on Willow Drive, Airdrie from the extended west kerb line of Holly Street, north eastwards to the extended west kerblines of Poplar Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on Holly Street at the west side of the closure wishing to travel generally south eastwards on Holly Street, north eastwards on Craigneuk Avenue, north westwards on Hawthorn Drive, south westwards on Oakbank Street, north westwards on Poplar Street, to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on Willow Drive at the east side of the closure wishing to travel to Holly Street at the west side of the closure should travel generally south eastwards on Poplar Street, north eastwards on Oakbank Street, south eastwards on Hawthorn Drive, south westwards on Craigneuk Avenue, north westwards on Holly Street, to the west side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to Lime Crescent will be maintained during the closure.
