

North Lanarkshire Council
Craigneuk Avenue, Airdrie
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2022

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Craigneuk Avenue, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2022" which continues restrictions currently in place by virtue of a similar order made by the Council on the eighteenth day of October, Two thousand and one, will only be operational when displayed by signs and shall be effective during the period from 2359 hours on Friday, the fourth day of February, Two thousand and twenty-two until 2359 hours on Thursday, the fourth day of May, Two thousand and twenty-two.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Water – Sewer Works) on Craigneuk Avenue, Airdrie as outlined below, by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Phase 1

From a point 40 metres or thereby, from the extended eastern kerb line of Hawthorn Drive, south westwards to a point 20 metres or thereby, from the extended western kerb line of Hawthorn Drive.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on Hawthorn Drive at the north side of the closure wishing to travel to Craigneuk Avenue at the east side of the closure should travel generally north westwards on Hawthorn Drive, north eastwards on Oakbank Street, south eastwards on Willow Drive, south westwards on Craigneuk Avenue, to the east side of the closure and vice versa.

Vehicles on Hawthorn Drive at the north side of the closure wishing to travel to Hawthorn Drive at the south side of the closure should travel generally north westwards on Hawthorn Drive, north eastwards on Oakbank Street, south eastwards on Willow Drive, south eastwards on Bankhead Avenue, south westwards on Howletnest Road, north westwards on Hawthorn Drive to the south side of the closure and vice versa.

Vehicles on Hawthorn Drive at the north side of the closure wishing to travel to Craigneuk Avenue at the west side of the closure should travel generally north westwards on Hawthorn Drive, south westwards on Oakbank Street, north westwards on Poplar Street, south westwards on Willow Drive, south eastwards on Holly Street, north eastwards on Craigneuk Avenue, to the west side of the closure and vice versa.

Vehicles on Craigneuk Avenue at the east side of the closure wishing to travel to Hawthorn Drive at the south side of the closure should travel generally north eastwards on Craigneuk Avenue, eastwards on Willow Drive, south eastwards on Bankhead Avenue, south westwards on Howletnest Road, north westwards on Hawthorn Drive to the south east side of the closure and vice versa.

Vehicles on Craigneuk Avenue at the east side of the closure wishing to travel to Craigneuk Avenue at the west side of the closure should travel generally north eastwards on Craigneuk

Avenue, north westwards on Willow Drive, south eastwards on Holly Street, north eastwards on Craigneuk Avenue, to the west side of the closure and vice versa.

Vehicles on Hawthorn Drive at the south side of the closure wishing to travel to Craigneuk Avenue at the west side of the closure should travel generally south eastwards on Hawthorn Drive, westwards on Howletnest Road, north eastwards on Craigneuk Avenue to the west side of the closure and vice versa.

Phase 2

From the extended eastern kerb line of Access road to Penny Cars Stadium, westwards to the extended western kerb line of Howletnest Road.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on Craigneuk Avenue at the west side of the closure wishing to travel to Craigneuk Avenue at the east side of the closure should travel generally westwards on Craigneuk Avenue, southwards on A73 Carlisle Road, north eastwards on B8058 Petersburn Road, north westwards on Bankhead Avenue, westwards on Willow Drive, south westwards on Craigneuk Avenue, to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on Craigneuk Avenue at the east side of the closure wishing to travel to Craigneuk Avenue at the west side of the closure should travel generally north eastwards on Craigneuk Avenue, eastwards on Willow Drive, south eastwards on Bankhead Avenue, south westwards on B8058 Petersburn Road, northwards on A73 Carlisle Road, eastwards on Craigneuk Avenue, to the west side of the closure.

Phase 3

From the extended eastern kerb line of Hawthorn Drive, north eastwards to the extended western kerblines of Willow Drive.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on Craigneuk Avenue at the west side of the closure wishing to travel to Craigneuk Avenue, at the east side of the closure should travel generally north westwards on Hawthorn Drive, north eastwards on Oakbank Street, south eastwards on Willow Drive, to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on Craigneuk Avenue at the east side of the closure wishing to travel to Craigneuk Avenue at the west side of the closure should travel generally north westwards on Willow Drive, south westwards on Oakbank Street, south eastwards on Hawthorn Drive, to the west side of the closure.

These works will be carried out as part of a rolling programme across 3 phases and no two closures will take place at any one time.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

Vehicular access for residents will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
