A8011 Wilderness Brae, Cumbernauld

(Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2022

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (A8011 Wilderness Brae, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2022" and shall be effective during the period from 0600 hours on Monday, the thirty-first day of January, Two thousand and twenty-two until 1800 hours on Friday, the eighteenth day of March, Two thousand and twenty-two.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge repair works) on the undernoted locations by reason of works being executed on or near that location.
3. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph

Temporary Road Closures

A8011 Central Way Northbound from Slip Road 1 to Slip Road 2

Alternative routes: Northbound traffic will be diverted via Slip Road 1 and Slip Road 2

Northbound traffic exiting to travel on B8054 Lye Brae southbound will be diverted via Slip Road 1, Slip Road 3 Braehead Roundabout, Slip Road 4, Slip Road 5 and B8054 Lye Brae

B8054 Lye Brae Northbound from Slip Road 6 to Slip Road 1

Alternative routes: Northbound traffic will be diverted via Slip Road 3, A8011 Central Way, Town Centre East Roundabout, A8011 Central Way and Slip Road 1.

In addition to the road closures a temporary 40mph speed limit will also be in place on the unernoted road -

A8011 Wilderness Brae – Central Way, Cumbernauld from 150m north of Braehead Roundabout Off-slip to A8011 Central Way at Existing 40mph Speed Limit Signs.
