

North Lanarkshire Council
Stewart Crescent, Newmains
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2022

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Stewart Crescent, Newmains) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2022" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the fourth day of July, Two thousand and twenty-two until 2359 hours on Sunday, the thirty-first day of July, Two thousand and twenty-two.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on construction of a new development access) on Stewart Crescent, Newmains from the extended west kerbline of A73 Westwood Road, south westwards for a distance of 60 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access Stewart Crescent should proceed via A73 Westwood Road, Murdostoun View and King Street to Stewart Crescent.

Vehicles on Stewart Crescent wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
