Various Roads, Holytown – Public Procession

(Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2022

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 62 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Various Roads, Holytown – Public Procession) (Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2022” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours until 1800 hours on Saturday, the ninth day of July, Two thousand and twenty-two.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the public procession) on the undernoted roads by reason of the planned event on or near that location.

Dornoch Road, Holytown from the junction with Myrtle Drive to the junction with Sunnyside Crescent.

Sunnyside Crescent, Holytown over its entire length.

St Andrews Street, Holytown over its entire length.

A775 Main Street, Holytown from the junction with St Andrews Street to the junction with B799 Stevenston Street.

B799 Stevenston Street, Holytown over its entire length.

B7029 Clydesdale Street, New Stevenston from the junction with the B799 Stevenston Street to the junction with the B799 Jerviston Street.

B7029 Carfin Street, New Stevenston from the junction with the B799 Jerviston Street to the junction with the A723 Carfin-Holytown Link Road.

Loanhead Road, New Stevenston from the junction with the A723 to Quarry Street.

Quarry Street, New Stevenston from Loanhead Road to the junction with Jerviston Street.

A723 Carfin-Holytown Link Road from the junction with B7029 Carfin Street to the junction with A775 Main Street/Edinburgh Road.

Jerviston Street, New Stevenston from a point 100 metres from its junction with the B799 Stevenston Street, south eastwards to its termination.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing access to the south side of the closure should proceed via the A775 Edinburgh Road, A73 Carlisle Road, B7066 Motherwell Road, B7066 High Street, B7066 Carfin Road, B7066 Newarthill Road, B7066 Motherwell Road and A723 Carfin – Holytown Link Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing access to the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

No Waiting and No Loading at Any Time from 0001 Hours until 1800 Hours

Dornoch Road, Holytown from the junction with Myrtle Drive to the junction with Sunnyside Crescent on both sides of the road.

Pedestrian access will be permitted at all times, during the closure.

Vehicular access will be permitted under the direction of Police Scotland where possible during the closure.
