Lanrig Road, Chryston

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2022

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Lanrig Road, Chryston) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2022" and shall be effective during the period from 0800 hours on Monday, the twenty fifth day of April, Two thousand and twenty-two until 1800 hours on Monday, the second day of May, Two thousand and twenty-two.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on connection to Scottish Water sewer) on Lanrig Road, Chryston from Drumsack Avenue to Campsie View or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles will be diverted via Campsie View, Greenlea Road and Drumsack Avenue

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
