Loch Road, Stepps

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2022

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Loch Road, Stepps) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2022" which continues the restrictions currently in place by virtue of a similar order made by the Council on Monday, the ninth day of August, Two thousand and twenty-one, shall be effective during the period from 2359 hours on Friday, the first day of April, Two thousand and twenty-two until Tuesday, the thirty-first day of May, Two thousand and twenty-two.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on road reconstruction works) on Loch Road, Stepps from Pear Tree Drive to Balmore Crescent by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles will be diverted via Loch Road, Clayhouse Road, Cardowan Road, A80 Cumbernauld Road and Loch Road.

Pedestrian and vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
