Main Street, Chryston

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2022

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Main Street, Chryston) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 20**" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the fourth day of April, Two thousand and twenty-two until 2359 hours on Monday, the eighteenth day of April, Two thousand and twenty-two.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on Main Street, Chryston from B819 Lindsaybeg Road to Solway Place by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Main Street, Chryston Road, A752 Cumbernauld Road and Lindsaybeg Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
