A73 Main Street, Newmains

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2022

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (A73 Main Street, Newmains) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2022" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the sixth day of June, Two thousand and twenty-two until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twenty-eighth day of August, Two thousand and twenty-two.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on construction of two new roundabouts as part of an adjacent development site) on A73 Main Street, Newmains from its junction with A71 Overtown Road southwards for a distance of 850m or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing access to the south side of the closure should proceed via A71 Overtown Road, A721 Wishaw Road and A73 Main Street. Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing access to the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
