Waverley Drive, Wishaw

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2022

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Waverley Drive, Wishaw) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2022" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the fourth day of July, Two thousand and twenty-two until 2359 hours on Monday, the fifteenth day of August, Two thousand and twenty-two.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the upgrade of residential gas supplies) on Waverley Drive, Wishaw from the junction with Kenilworth Avenue, eastwards to the junction with Coltness Road, a distance of 610 metres or thereby, in 2 phases as outlined below by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Phase 1

From Kenilworth Avenue to Ryde Road.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed via Waverley Drive, Dryburgh Road, Kitchener Street, B7033 Lammermoor Terrace and Ryde Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Phase 2

Waverley Drive from Ryde Road to Coltness Road.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed via Ryde Road, A722 Kirk Road then Coltness Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure (Faraday Avenue) wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed via Faraday Avenue, A722 Kirk Road then Ryde Road to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access Faraday Avenue should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure (Faraday Avenue) wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed via Faraday Avenue, A722 Kirk Road then Coltness Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access Faraday Avenue should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure (Abbotsford Road) wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed via Abbotsford Road, Abbotsford Crescent, Coltness Road Service Road, Coltness Road, A722 Kirk Road then Ryde Road to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access Abbotsford Road should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure on Abbotsford Road wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed via Abbotsford Road, Abbotsford Crescent, Coltness Road Service Road then Coltness Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on Woodstock Drive will be directed through the works area to either the west or east side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

Residential access will be maintained, where practicable by arrangement with the contractor.
