Community Achievements

Over the past 4 years we have successfully challenged planning applications from developers Cala, Walker and Ogilvie Homes to build more homes in the Westerwood area.

With the supportive assistance of Councillor Alan Masterton re-planting of trees at St Andrews Drive has been accomplished.

New 30 mph signs have been erected at the entrance to Dullatur Road and 20 mph roundels have been painted on Kings Drive.

Community Achievements (contd.)

Volunteers have helped with a number of rubbish clearances across the Westerwood area, as well as re-painting white bollards at various locations.

Cutting back overgrown grass and weeds along verges and pavements by local residents is an ongoing process.

Each year funds have been provided to Muirfield Road residents to set up a Christmas Tree with lights.

Community Police

A new community officer, Emma Wardrope, has been appointed and is looking forward to attending future meetings.

Westerwood Community Funds

A resident noted that there seemed to be a discrepancy in the figure between the one quoted in the minutes of a previous meeting and the present total which stands at £2112.44 in the bank account, and £104.35 in petty cash. This was explained as an oversight and the Financial Report, prepared and audited by Feely & Co, would be made available to residents at the next public meeting.
