

Councillor Adam Smith notes for meeting 2nd August 22 at Seafar and Ravenswood Community Council.

Hi Pauline,

- Arranged for inspection of structures and roads in the area, including Seafar Road outside the petrol station and an unstable wall in Mitchison Road. Repairs will be undertaken soon on the road surface outside the petrol station. The wall in Mitchison Road is under private ownership, apart from a very small section, so there's nothing which can be done but there is no risk of injury to those passing by should it collapse. The footpath will also shortly be resurfaced between South Muirhead Road and Asda.
- Approached by the property team to advise there are two applications to convert public land to private gardens, at Lairds Hill and Darroch Way.
- Response from Sanctuary to advise they have no plans to change the fencing at Ochilview Court, at the corner of the path towards the underpass into Darroch Way. This was following a complaint from a resident that their property was being overlooked.
- (Finally) got the bin emptied, or removed, next to St Mungo's Church.
- Arranged for a traffic and speed survey to be carried out in Allanfauld Road after the school holidays following a complaint from a local resident.
- Asked for the footpath to be swept at Fergusson Road.
- Provided advice to a Seafar resident on setting up a mental health support organisation.
- Arranged for repairs to be carried out to the Muirfield bin store in Brown Road.
- Asked for a bin to be installed at the Muirfield play park and for cleaning of the area.
- Queried the effectiveness of CCTV at Muirfield and arranged for the bin store and play area to be regularly monitored.
- Arranged for Sanctuary to put signs in Ochilview Court advising the area is for resident parking only following a complaint from a resident of the car park being used by patrons of the British Legion.
