**Daviesdyke Road, Allanton**

**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2022**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Daviesdyke Road, Allanton) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2022" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the eighth day of August, Two thousand and twenty-two until 2359 hours on Sunday, the fourth day of September, Two thousand and twenty-two.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Water Network Improvement Works) on Daviesdyke Road, Allanton from the extended west kerbline of Dura Road westwards for a distance of 980m or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing access to Daviesdyke Road should proceed via Dura Road, Allanton Road (A71), Coltness Avenue, Mill Road and Watsonfoot Road to Daviesdyke Road.*

*Vehicles on Daviesdyke Road to the west side of the closure wishing access to the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
