Belgrave Street, Bellshill

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2022

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Belgrave Street, Bellshill) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2022" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty-second day of August, Two thousand and twenty-two until 2359 hours on Sunday, the fourth day of September, Two thousand and twenty-two.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Sewer Connection Works) on Belgrave Street, Bellshill from its junction with Cubitt Court, northwards for a distance of 100 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles should proceed on Belgrave Street, A721 Gartcosh Walk, A725 Bellshill Bypass and James Street.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
