AC welcomes everyone to the meeting. There will be no police report as they are not in attendance and nothing had been sent via email prior to the meeting starting.

AC congratulated AM on his win at the local election and also our former Community Council vice chair Ann Ballinger, who has also been selected. This means however, she can no longer stand in Community Council but can still attend as a resident. AC has said she will arrange a thank you gift for her years of service to the community.

Previous minutes – March – approved by AC and seconded by BK

April – approved by AC and seconded by GM

Easter event went well, letter of thanks to be sent to Doreen at Tesco Craigmarloch.

Issue of drinking in the community park at the last day of school for S4-6 pupils due to study leave, this will be monitored and any vandalism etc. reported.

Secretaries report (CM) nothing other than weekly planning lists that are forwarded to all on receipt.

Treasurers report (GM) will email to be included.

GM is preparing accounts for the end of March to go to auditor. Agreed old assets can be written off. Insurance must be renewed.

Dullatur Golf Club (DGC) car park update – GM said that the temporary car park that was installed without permission should be reinstated to landscaped area by and of June this year. We are awaiting an update on this matter. MC suggested it would be good to be involved with the reinstating to landscape as it may help add trees to make up for potential losses in Glen Falloch (private land purchase to extend garden). GM/BK will discuss types of trees.

Glen Douglas Drive (GDD) still an array of issues here, road has been dug up for longer that residents were notified of, lights are still not repaired, and all grass verges are mud. AM will ask roads department for an update and timetable of works completion. No one can occupy until dropped curbs are finished. Need to make sure the developers make good the whole area as soon as possible. AC constructing letter to NLC and will re-circulate to everyone for their input.

Phone mast – 3 have finally moved the fences. They are putting a new Planning application in for an area close by, but this is an issue as it will cause potential blind spots for anyone crossing.

MC spoke to a Senior Network Analyst for Scottish Water (SW), new site needs to be 20metres away from any sewage lines. 3 so far are not engaging with SW re: the £40K worth of damages caused by the last mast – there has been no consultation with SW on the new site which is concerning. There have been other masts in Gartcosh and Edinburgh that have been refused, need to investigate this and put together our objection. Agreed a newsletter needs to go out asap.
