Matters arising -

- Flower barrels now with G Stewart.
- Village Signage – now completed and looking great, photo shoot in local paper.
- Health Service paperwork completed and returned.
- CC attended meeting in cemetery – shortage of staff – maintenance out to contract at cost of £75,000 - photo in local paper.
- Waste Plant (Millershill) – Cllr Beveridge and G Stewart visited and assured us there is no smell to surrounding area. Application for Waste Plant at Greengairs (alternative to landfill), would handle 4 to 500,000 tons waste.

Treasurer Report –

AOCB –

- Play park – considerable amount of waterlogged land following site investigation – second lot of drilling has caused this – encroached 9 metres into play park surrounding space – proposal to move play park.
- Pedal for Scotland – last year.
- Parking in Rydenmains Road – no further notice – point was raised concerning congestion resulting from lack of parking space at bottom of Rydenmains Road.
- Hospital – process as to how Gartcosh site was reached being investigated – other sites considered before end of year.
- Minutes have been submitted to allow grant to be paid.
