PROPOSED DECISION

To consider the request and thereafter donate an appropriate sum to the Society.

REPORT

The Council has received a request from the above Society for a donation to help towards the cost of two schemes, the first run by themselves and the second a joint scheme between the SSPCA and BSAVA, both of which neuter dogs and cats re-homed from the Society's centres.

The object of both schemes is to reduce the number of unwanted stray dogs and cats in circulation and as such is in keeping with the aims of the Council to reduce the danger to the public from the stray dog and cat population. It should also be pointed out that the kennelling operation for the Council in terms of the Dog Warden Service is operated by the SSPCA.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Council consider making an appropriate donation to the Society.
