PROPOSED DECISION:

The Committee is asked to note the statutorily increased fees detailed in the report.

FINANCIAL RESOURCES:

The Council will receive these increased fees for the issue of Licences to Store Petroleum Spirit from 1st January 1998.

REPORT

The Health and Safety (Fees) Regulations 1997, which came into force on 18 November, stipulate the scale of fees which the local Petroleum Licensing Authority may charge for the storage of petroleum spirit, which includes petrol, for one calendar year.
